Our Program: The National Archives of Ireland are scheduled to release the results of the 1926 Irish Census – the first enumeration conducted by the Irish Free State – on April 18. Join Forum members and historian Dr. Noel Carolan as we prepare for this long-awaited event. Dr. Carolan will highlight the unique insights the 1926 Census will provide into Irish families, their neighbors, employers, and living conditions. He will outline the political and economic contexts of the Census and the information it will contain. Dr. Carolan will provide handouts listing selected resources to help you kickstart your family history research before the Census release date.

Our Speaker: Dr Noel Carolan, historian, received his Ph.D. from Dublin City University. His dissertation dealt with the political history of Ireland's food supply from 1895 to 1923. He is a longtime member of the Raheny Heritage Society in Dublin, which divides its time between local history and family history.
